Goodmanham Parish Council Update.

Highways and parking remain an on going issue with ERYC. Councillor Leo Hammond is consulting with ERYC highways team on our behalf. As a result of the white hatchings at the northern end of the village, the highway verge against the church wall is slowly recovering.

A grant application has been submitted to Sancton Windfarm Community Fund to help with the ongoing maintenance of the car park.

Now the water leak has been repaired close to Rose Villa we are hopeful for the pavement paths to be resurfaced. Also for the sides of Red Lane to be repaired. We have been told work will commence once highways have completed their works in Market Weighton.

The Parish Council is looking to arrange some Defibrillator Training providing there are adequate numbers. The training, run by the Community Heartbeat Trust, will last about 2 hours. If you are interested please contact the Clerk <u>clerk.goodmanham@live.co.uk</u> it is intended to hold the training session in the autumn at the Fiddle Drill.

Finally, there have been reports of antisocial behaviour on the road bridge and also at the northern end of the village. Parishioners are requested to phone 101 to get reports logged, thus enabling the police to monitor.
